We all should know what is in our governing documents and in our rules regarding our personal responsibilities for living here. These are all in place to keep our Community inviting and our property values up.

Yard Sale signs abound this time of year in LT. Yes, this is another good way to get rid of unwanted stuff and to make a little money in the process. Please do your part and remove any signs you have posted. Missing pet signs fall into this category as well

The Blessing Box that is located near the office is a nice opportunity where we can help others. There is a sign posted on the front that only non-perishable goods are allowed. Even with this, why people leave opened food goods, clothing, household items, books, magazines, cards, and even footwear is perplexing. Do not leave these items, they will be discarded.

Know your residential property lines and what is your responsibility. LT common area is not available for residents to plant in or hang personal items on trees or place decorations on.

Again, to repeat, do not perform alterations to your yard or the outside of your home without approval of an Architectural Application. This is required. You can incur fines for ignoring this. You can be held liable for damages to others property or Common area if something should occur.

If you have received a compliance notice, please, take a good look at the reason(s) noted in the letter. It's difficult when Members get upset and angry at the Board and the office for simply doing what we are required to do. Another way to look at this...all members pay for all infraction(s). We each pay for LT employees time spent on this, letters generated, mailing costs, communication requirements, follow ups, and (uncompensated) Board efforts. Plus, the visual impacts are obvious.

Take a moment to reflect on the amounts of time, energy and money that is outlaid monthly trying to keep a handle on keeping up our pleasant appearance. And before someone says, I pay for this or that that needs repair or completion. Why is that taking forever? Remember, the Management and Board are subject to finding good value for our money. That takes research time, bid time, costs involved, contractor availability, Member input (if necessary) etc, etc. We'd like it off our to-do-list, too.


