GREENTREE DEVELOPMENT UPDATE From Marj Kelly and Chris Winther

Construction Begins

Gilley Way will be closing permanently in early September, perhaps as soon as the first week, as Phase 1 of the GreenTree Development begins. Gilley Way will be replaced by a new street, Village Way (opposite Poplar Rd). Current activity in the area is in preparation for Phase 1 construction. Signage will go up a couple of days in advance of the Gilley Way closure. Phase 1 development will include:

September 5th development getting underway

- Development of the D3* detention basin (along Horse Creek which runs by the storage units)
- Development of the R7* apartment site (adjacent to the new detention basin)
- Stockpiling of materials on the C1* commercial pad in the area near the apartments

NOTE: Phase 1 does not include any construction south of Sequoia.

Dead Tree Removal

An arborist will be providing an estimate on August 28 for the removal of 3 dead trees in proximity to homes along Golf Course Estates. LTHA will be informed when the work is to commence.
